Cookie Decorating: Show us your decorating skills on your favorite type of cookie!

Crafts: Painting, Models, Sketching, Legos or Any other craft: This can be an art project from school or just your own creative design or model.

Dinosaurs: Tell us about your favorite dinosaur!

Dolphins & Whales (the Ocean): Make a model or display of your favorite whale, dolphin or ocean scene.

Entomology: Do you like to collect bugs? Display actual insects you have collected or poster.

Flowers: This can be a flower you have grown yourself or you may purchase and then make your own arrangement.

Foods: Make your favorite popcorn snack, no-bake cookies or marshmallow treats.

Home Furnishings: Make an item for your room or your house.

Horseless Horseman: Create a poster about your favorite breed of horse.

Livestock Showman: Pair up with an older 4-Her to learn how to show goats, sheep, swine, rabbits and chickens.

Photography: Do you like to take pictures? If so, show us your best shots!

Sewing: Make a pillow and add decorative buttons or patches on it. This may be handsewn or machine sewn.

Shooting Sports: Do you like to hunt? This is a fun project about Indiana game, making turkey calls, or just the different firearms.

Small Animals: Create a poster or notebook about your pet.

Sportfishing: Love to fish? Show us your skills are casting a line or telling us about the different types of fish.
